Immediate next step: ratification process

General Council has adopted Protocol 27 Nov. 2014.

- Members to go through their internal treaty ratification process and notify acceptance of protocol to WTO
- L The Protocol will be open open-ended.
- The Agreement will enter into force once 2/3 of the WTO Members ratify it

3 different categories of commitments: A, B & C


Cat. C provisions implementation process







Category B notification and implementation




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Category C Notification and implementation



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Timeline for Developing Countries

By the date of the Protocol's adoption: Notify Category A provisions

ASAP: Deposit acceptance of the Protocol to the WTO (implied)

Upon entry into force

- Implement Category A provisions
- Notify Category B and C provisions along with indicative dates
- Inform the CTF on arrangements required for implementation of Category C provisions

Within one year of entry into force

- Notify definitive dates for implementation of Category B provisions.
- Inform the CTF on **arrangement made** or entered into for implementation of Category C provisions

Within two and a half years after entry into force


- Notify the **definitive dates** for implementation of Category C provisions
- Provide information to the CTF on the progress made on provision of assistance and support

Project on the TF implementation Plans

The project activities

- Update, complete and expand, as required, the national WTO needs assessment
- Prepare a national action plan for the implementation of necessary actions to ensure compliance with WTO TF rules

The project approach

- Relying on the local knowledge and employing national consultants supervised by UNCTAD and/or other Annex D organizations' staff.
- In-country events, one to initiate the diagnostics and another one at the end to validate the results

Key questions to be discussed for each measure

- 1 Is your administration already implementing this measure?
- 2 What could be the appropriate category for this measure?
- **3** Do you need external assistance to implement this measure?
- 4 How much time would be required to implement the measure?
- 5 What would be the main activities and resources required to implement this measure?
- 6 Which Ministry / department is best suited to lead and ensure implementation of the measure?


