Let me present my compliments to you and express my deep gratitude for the assistance provided for many years by the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe for trade development and facilitation in Ukraine, notably, for its support to the innovative project of a "Single Window" in the ports of Odessa: the first Port Community System in the transition economies, and for establishing a national trade facilitation body.

The Port Community System pilot project is a prelude to larger national projects in Ukraine.
